We ended the first half term with several celebrations – two of which are particularly close to our hearts as we acknowledged and thanked our fabulous Teachers and their Assistants.

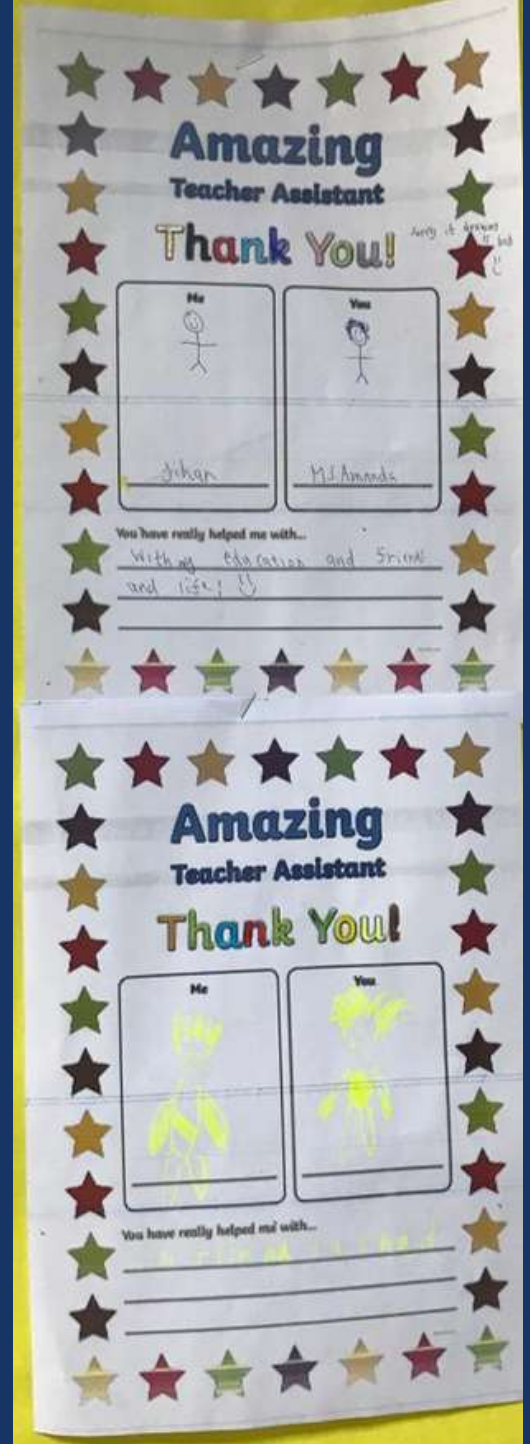

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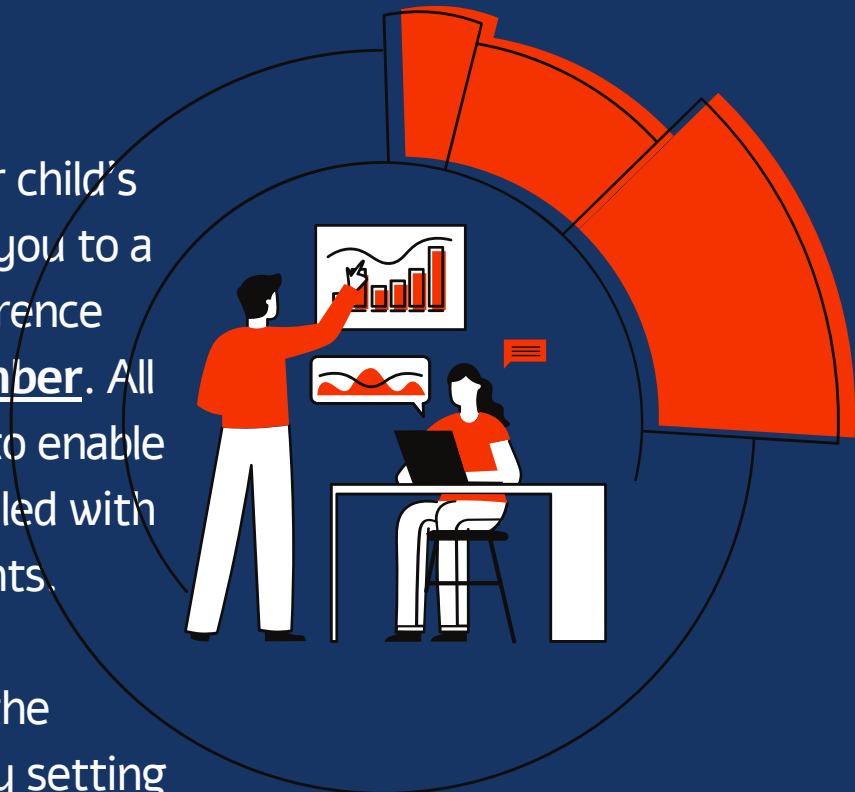


Reports & PTSCs – a date for your diary
