As per ADEK guidelines, we cannot provide online learning for students unless they are a positive case, or if they have a certificate stating they are in quarantine due to being in contact with a positive case.

As per ADEK guidelines, all students do have the option of moving to online learning, however this will be until the end of term 2.

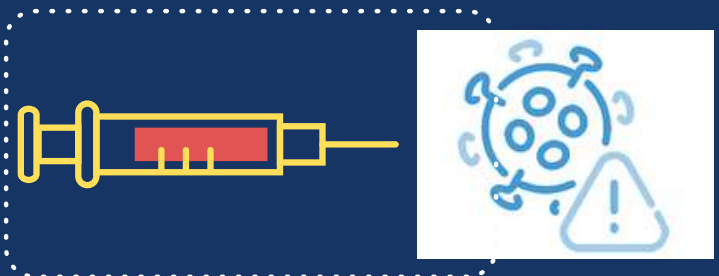
