– Flour – Pasta – Rice – Cereals – Canned items – Crackers

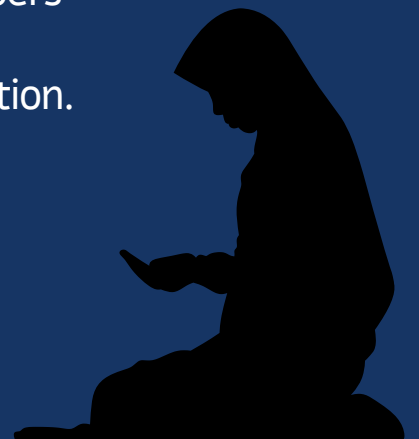
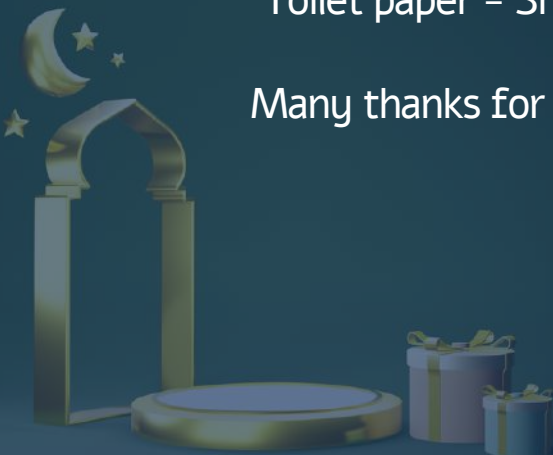
### Cleaning items:
