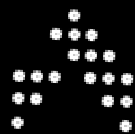




## Vision, Mission and Values

The school would never charge students to attend the National Day. It is **OPTIONAL** to purchase ice cream and / or popcorn.

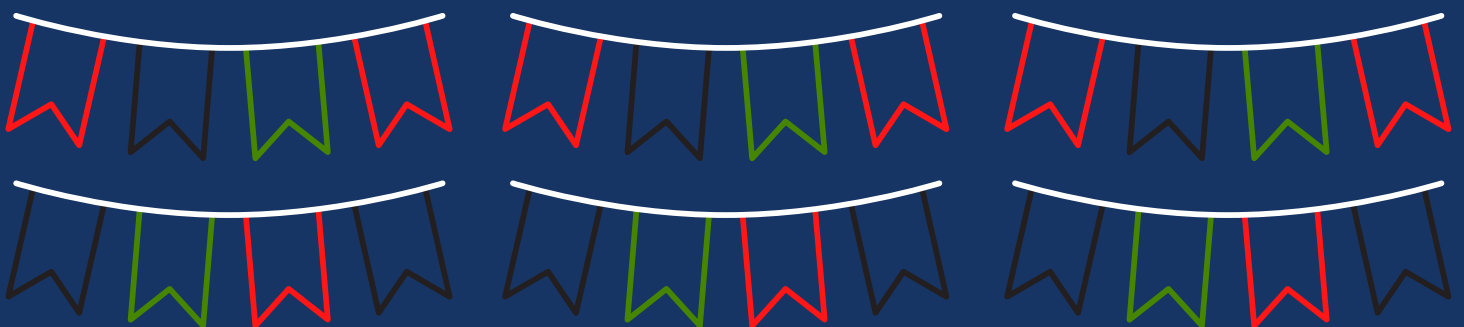
