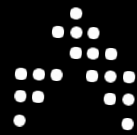




Vision, Mission and Values

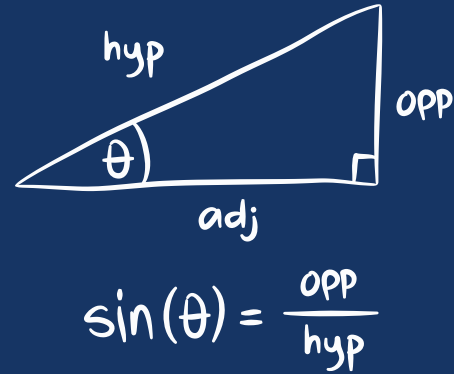
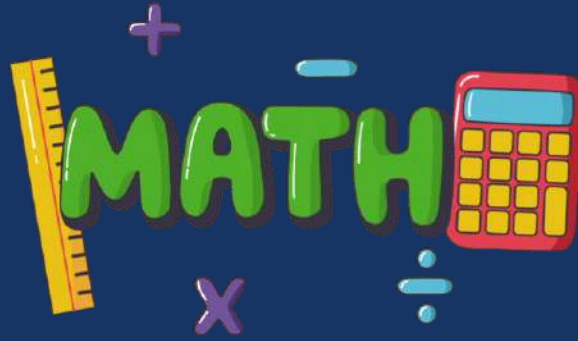
ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE

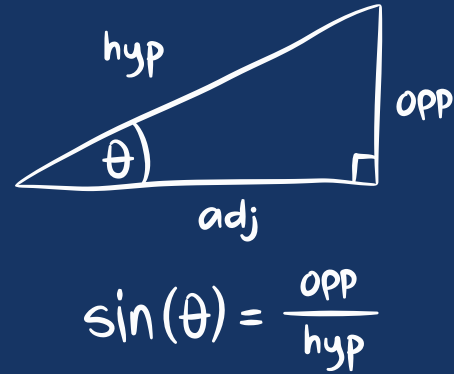
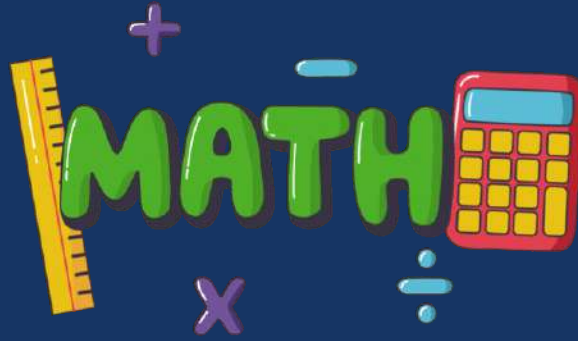
