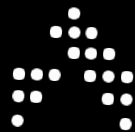




## Vision, Mission and Values

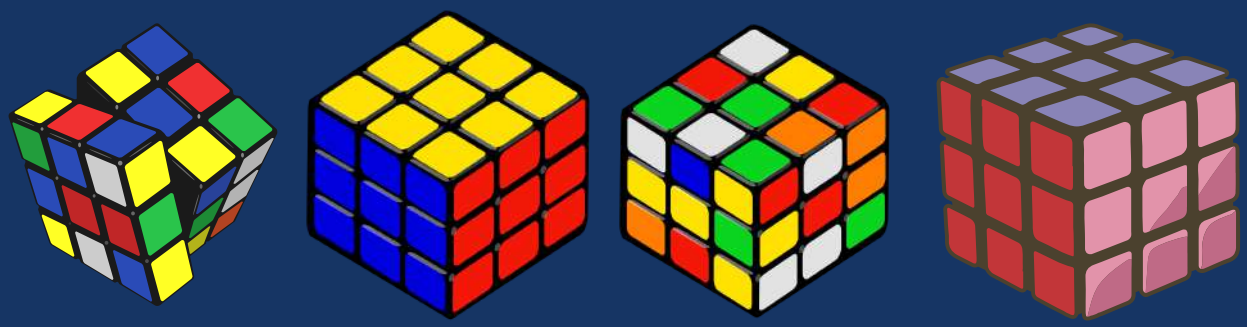
