


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We celebrated International Literacy Day royally here in school:

BBS participates this year in this campaign on Friday, September 22, 2023, we are going to:


 Wear Jeans: Wear jeans to support the cause on the designated day. You can pair them with your school T-shirt or wear Blue if you do not own jeans.
