







MATHS




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Ms Clair would like to now add a few words about yet another one of our marvelous students:



Many of our students are natural linguists and we embrace this huge advantage here in school.


We look forward to some amazing opportunities with our wonderful Board of Governors and the leadership of the Alliance together with the French Embassy.
